

Travis Barker Style Drum Fill

In this week's lesson we have got a nice little 16th note drum fill which in my opinion sounds like the sort of drum lick you would expect to hear from Travis Barker, so if you enjoy his style of playing you might enjoy this one. It has a basic sticking pattern, combining single strokes and kicks. We have got a double crash leading from the 'a' of beat 4 into beat 1 of the following bar. below is a breakdown of the different stages we can build the fill from the video.

The repeated six note pattern

R L R L R K

This is beat 4 of the fill leading into the following measure

2 R L R K&L K&R

The complete drum fill

A 4 bar loop to practice playing the fill in context.
