

Drum Fill Ideas & 32nd Notes

In this weeks lesson we have got another great sounding drum fill idea that works great in any mid-tempo or double time groove. We begin with a basic R L K pattern using 16th notes and then have a go at doubling the notes with the hands and playing four 32nd notes, followed by a 16th note kick drum. When we get the hang of that, we then finish of the lesson by doubling the kick drums to create a solid 32nd note drum fill.

Here is the basic 16th note drum fill played between the snare and kick drum



Now we double up what the hands were doing, so now you are playing four 32nd notes before our 16th note on the kick drum.



Here is a basic voicing idea from the video.



Finally, we double the kick drum in to 32nd notes.
