

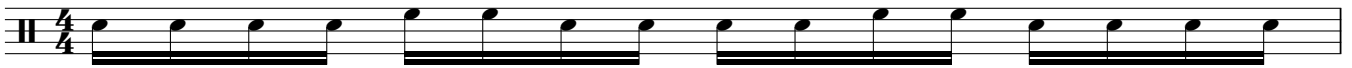
Fast Travis Barker Style Drum Fill

This is a simple concept in which we combine two basic single stroke 16th note drum fill ideas around the kit. In this lesson I have put together a simple orchestration using the snare, high tom and floor tom. The idea is to learn this pattern and increase your speed to create drum fills that you might here drummers such as Travis Barker play.

The cool thing about this concept is that it simple enough so that beginners can have a go, as well as being a speed challenge for more advanced players.

This is part 1 of our drum fill. Beginners can use this as an idea for a basic single measure fill.
